FLIXTON GOLF CLUB -- LADIES SECTION

LOCAL RULES GOVERNING COMPETITIONS

- 1. Ladies presentations will be held on the first Wednesday of the month or a Prize Day.
- 2. In order to qualify to enter for the Lady Captain's Prize a player must:-
 - (a) Return three medal scores at this Club, in competitions during the season commencing March 1st.
 - (b) Hold, or has held, a handicap of 36 or lower at this Club.
 - (c) All names to be on the sheet at least seven days prior to Lady Captain's Prize Day
 - (d) The maximum handicap allowed in the competition is thirty.
- 3. Names of competitors must be entered in the Competition Book, or the competition fee placed in the box, before going out to play.

Penalty: DISQUALIFICATION.

Times on the competition sheet cannot be changed after midnight of the day prior to the competition, but can be added on the competition day.

4. Competitors shall play in two or three balls.

5. Except when otherwise specially provided for, competition play must not start before 10.30 a.m. 1st tee reserved 10.30am until 1pm.

6 Rules regarding a tie:

In the Lady Captain's Prize and Gold Medal competitions a tie shall be decided by a replay over 18 holes within the week. At least two alternative dates for the replay must be given by each participant. In the event of a second tie a further eighteen holes are to be played, the conditions above to be applied. In all other competitions Par, Stableford. Monthly Medals, Prize Days, Invitation and Open competitions, a tie shall be decided on a card playoff over the last nine ,six, three or one hole(s).

For twelve hole competitions a tie shall be decided over the last six, three or one hole(s). Handicap shall be deducted in proportion where appropriate. If a card play-off fails to give a result over the last half of the card the result shall be a joint win.

- 7. In Gold Medal competition, no competitor shall start before 11:00am if, because of weather conditions, the Gold Medal Competition cannot be played then it must be played on the next competition day.
- 8. Competitors shall arrange their own partners except for the Gold Medal.
- 8. A Competition prize will not be presented unless there is a minimum entry of :-Six in Medal, Par and Stableford competitions

10. Winter Play. All competitions will be over twelve holes from the beginning of November to the end of February.

11. In the event of unsettled weather on Prize Days, a decision will be taken by the donor of the Prize and the Lady Captain or one other member of the committee.-

12. Non-Competition Cards.

(a) Extra Day Cards must be marked as Stableford points and are acceptable only if they reduce the handicap.

(b) To attain / re-attain an E.W.G.A. handicap. Three medal cards are required or sufficient to increase the number of scores returned since the beginning of the previous E.W.G.A. year to three.

(c) Play off Red Tees.

- (a) Before marking a card, a player must indicate her intention to do so by entering her name in the competition book. Cards marked on any shortened or temporary course are not acceptable.
- (e) Cards must be marked in two's.
- (f) EDC's cannot be marked for handicapping in a competition.
- 13. Starred Prize Days.

If the donor of the prize wishes to play in the competition she may either enter her name in the Competition Book and pay the full fee, in order that her score may qualify for the Gold Medal, or enter her name in the Competition Book and pay no fee.

14. On E.W.G.A. Competition Days, when the playability of the course is in doubt, a decision will be made by the course assessors.

15. Summer and Four Ball Tournaments:

Entrance fees to be put in an envelope and placed in the Competition Box before the starting date of the competitions. Maximum handicap-36 Singles – Full difference. Doubles_ 90% of difference. Tees – Red markers to be used. The first Competitors named to arrange the match and drive off at the first tee.

Ladies are requested to comply with Flixton Golf Club's dress code on the course and within the Club House.
